


Activate & Connect

Please plug in mains electricity cable and the USB WLAN card then switch the power on.



How to establish a Direct Connection

Before starting, please make sure you've downloaded the latest version of our "QAT" remote control app and also that the Music Server is switched on.

1. Open the settings menu on your iPad, select WLAN settings, and then connect to your Music Server's SSID. e.g.: QAT-MS5-XXXX
2. Enter the initial password "qatqatqat". Return to the home screen and open the QAT app.



You should now be connected to your Music Server and can change the password of your SSID to a secure password of your liking, which can be done easily with the QAT remote control app.

You may choose a different type of connection by changing the settings from the QAT App:

1. Open QAT remote control app
2. Tap the "Settings" button on the top right hand corner
3. Select "Network" from the column on the right side
4. Tap "Change" and select the Music Server from Wi-Fi list



【Cable connection & Network Settings】


Home Screen

Home Screen shows the album art and main function buttons once your music server is connected properly.



Drag-Play

Drag-Play: Tap-hold the display picture of any track or album, then drag it onto the playing icon. Or just touch the track name to play it.



Tap-holding the name of a radio station name or album will open another range of functions, play now, export to NAS, import to playlist or to export to USB devices.


Playlist

Select Playlist icon to enter playlist. You can create new lists, play, edit, and delete lists here.




CD Functions

The CD icon appears when a CD is inserted into the connected Music Server. Tapping the icon opens the CD album view, in which short tapping allows playing of tracks and tap-holding also allows importing any track or the whole album to the music server.



Internet Radio

Tap the Radio icon to access the Internet Radio function. On the radio screen you can search your favorite channels or just browse through the more than 3800 internet radio stations which are accessible through the QAT remote control app.



USB Storage Device

Tap the USB device icon to go to the USB storage menu. There, you can play tracks and export any number of songs or whole albums to the unit.




NAS

Click the cloud icon to go the NAS screen, where you can add, delete, edit, export, play and organize the songs or albums in your network attached storage (NAS).



System Settings

Tap the gear icon to access the system settings. The settings menu includes general app settings, network settings, information about music server usage and versions numbers, the NAS settings and the 'about' section.
